

«EUROPE CHANTIER Transfer of Innovation», A pilot project for Europe



The project **EUROPE CHANTIER-Transfer of Innovation (ECTI)** is the continuation of the pilot project EUROPE CHANTIER® implemented between 2003 and 2006. This new project has also been funded by the programme Leonardo Da Vinci for the period 2007-2009. ECTI brings together partners from 7 European countries (Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Poland, Spain, Romania) whose aim at opening EUROPE CHANTIER® to new countries, new public and in the respect of a quality approach.

The expected results of the project

The outcomes of the quality approach will be:

- the setting up of EUROPE CHANTIER agencies at a European, national, regional and/or sectoral level. The aim of these agencies is to assist any structure that wish to attend or organize a Euro-Chantier. The main procedures of management of the agencies have been defined in the framework of ISO 9001.
- the launch of the certification process of the profession called Europe Trainer (« Formateur à l'Europe »). This new profession has been defined in the framework of the European programme of sustainable professionalisation.
- the publication of two guidelines: guidance on the methodology for organizing a Euro-Chantier, and the guide on the training of Euro-Chantiers supervisors
- the creation of the Steering Committee which aims to ensure the respect of the EUROPE CHANTIER philosophy.

ABOUT EUROPE CHANTIER®

EUROPE CHANTIER, created by the French Association CRYVALIS, is a programme which aims at encouraging cooperation between European citizens by giving them the opportunity, during an international meeting called Euro-Chantier (« Euro-Workshop », to work together and to develop their notions of European identity and citizenship.

A Euro-Chantier brings together for periods of one or more weeks, participants that are taken in charge by a partner organization, for the purpose of furthering any projects they may have in common. The workshop can be of any nature: an application in the field of vocational training, an artistic creation, an event, a pedagogical innovation...

The participants will also benefit of a course on Europe (the Formation à l'Europe) that promotes European history, culture, values and Institutions. The aim of this training is to make them getting involved in the EU's future as future European citizens who are aware of their rights and their duties.
