

L'Europe en cours...



The project *L'Europe en cours...*, created by the French association CRYSLIS within the framework of the EUROPE CHANTIER programme, gives to European University students the opportunity to cooperate and participate in constructing some pedagogical programmes about Europe for youngsters students.

Step by step...

In 2008, 40 Master' students specialized in European issues and from 7 European countries (Belgium, Bulgaria, France, Italy, Poland, Romania, Czech Republic) worked together on a prototype of teaching manual about Europe for high school students. This manual is the result of the first phase called : «Make the high school students European citizens !», and it is presented in 5 chapters:

- Chapter 1: Where are the borders of Europe?
- Chapter 2: The birth of Europe
- Chapter 3: The European identity
- Chapter 4: The European citizenship
- Chapter 5: The European Union and its contributions

The second phase of the project started in September 2009. It aims to finalize the teaching manual developed in 2008. After a first period dedicated to the analysis of the handbook, 14 European students will be brought together during one week in March 2010, in Marseille (France). During this «Euro-Chantier» (name given to this

transnational meeting), they will propose different amendments of the manual.

Experts will also participate to the «Euro-Chantier». They will lead conferences and debates, and give the students some food for thought in order to improve the quality of the teaching manual.

What will happen after the Euro-Chantier?

After the Euro-Chantier, the teaching manual will be modified (taken into accounts the results of the Euro-Chantier), then, it will be translated and tested with European high school students. Finally, it will be published and diffused in the 7 partner countries and more over.

In the end, partners of the project will have the opportunity to interact with the high school students on European issues. They will be also able to train teachers to the active pedagogical approach used in the handbook.

Several similar Euro-Chantiers will be organized in the future to adapt the teaching manual to younger students (11-15 years old, 6-11 years old...).

The final objective of this project is to propose for teachers a new way to teach about Europe...

EUROPE CHANTIER, created by the French Association CRYSLIS, is a programme which aims at encouraging cooperation between European citizens by giving them the opportunity, during an international meeting called Euro-Chantier (« Euro-Workshop », to work together and to develop their notions of European identity and citizenship.

A Euro-Chantier brings together for periods of one or more weeks, participants that are taken in charge by a partner organization, for the purpose of furthering any projects they may have in common. The workshop can be of any nature: an application in the field of vocational training, an artistic creation, an event, a pedagogical innovation...

The participants will also benefit of a course on Europe (the Formation à l'Europe) that promotes European history, culture, values and Institutions. The aim of this training is to make them getting involved in the EU's future as future European citizens who are aware of their rights and their duties.
